



ZPA conveyors can be used to stage products in specific zones to complete a process or accumulate in zones while product is moved down the line.



AS/RS

Automatic Storage and Retrieval Systems (AS/RS) utilize automated cranes or shuttles to efficiently store pallets, boxes, or totes within a racking system without the use of manual processes. Conveyor moves product into AS/RS loading zones for automated pick up and storage inside the racking system. When product is called, an input signal is received and the control system extracts the product from racking, then delivers it to an outfeed station where it is picked up or transported to its destination. AS/RS systems utilize your floor space, vertical space, and labor more efficiently than conventional means by eliminating aisles, fork truck traffic and labor.
